Weekly Care Routine

Week of: _____

■ SUNDAY - Ground Floor Layer

■ 15-20 min

- Check soil moisture 2-3 inches deep
- Water if dry (typically every 7-10 days)
- Rotate pots 90° for even growth
- Wipe large leaves with damp cloth

■ TUESDAY - Mid-Level Layer

■ 10-15 min

- Check moisture of top inch of soil
- Water if dry (typically every 5-7 days)
- Prune dead leaves or leggy growth
- Check for proper drainage

■ THURSDAY - Upper Canopy Layer

■ 10 min

- Water trailing plants
- Trim excessive vining growth
- Check for pests on undersides of leaves
- Adjust hanging positions if needed

■ SATURDAY - Micro-Zones & General

■ 10 min

- Water micro-zone elements as needed
- Mist humidity-loving plants
- Refill propagation stations
- Fertilize (every 2-4 weeks during growing season)

■ Tip: Adjust frequency based on season, humidity, and plant needs.
